Our client, United Association Political Education Committee (UAPEC), has instructed us to respond to your notice dated October 2, 2012. We have enclosed a copy of that notice for your convenience.

The May 22, 2012 check to the David Michael Gill campaign was for 2012 Primary election debt reduction and not the 2012 Primary election. I will amend the June monthly report to correct this error. (A copy of the redesignation is attached)

The congressional district for Obernueller for Congress is MN-2nd and the congressional district for Kathleen Hochul is NY-26th. This will be corrected in the amended report.

On the original June 2012 Monthly report, I listed a memo entry redesignating a \$5,000 March 30, 2011 contribution to Kathleen Hochul from 2012 primary to Special General. That Special General election took place on May 24, 2011. In the amended report I will try to change the way it was reported to 2011 Special General. I hope that the software will allow that.

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 item(s):

1. Schedule B supporting Line 23 of your report discloses one or more contributions to a candidate(s) for the 2012 Primary election; however, the funds were disbursed after the election date(s) (see attached). Please note that contributions may not be designated for an election which has already occurred unless the funds are to be used to reduce a candidate committee's debts incurred during that election campaign. (11 CFR §§110.1(b)(3) and 110.2(b)(3))

If any apparently impermissible contribution in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you should amend your original report with clarifying information. If the contribution(s) in question should have been designated for debt retirement, you should amend your report to indicate "debt retirement," along with the year of election.

If you have made an impermissible contribution, you must request a refund or provide a written authorization for a redesignation of the contribution pursuant to 11 CFR §110.2(b) within 60 days of the treasurer's receipt.

Commission regulations require that these itemized disbursements include the recipient's full name, complete address, date, amount, purpose, state, office sought (House, Senate, or President), and district (if applicable). - Schedule B supporting Line 23 of your report discloses a contribution(s) to "KATHLEEN COURTNEY HOCHUL" designated for the 2012 Special-General. However, it appears this candidate(s) did not participate in the election(s) indicated. Please amend your report to clarify the election designation for this contribution(s).

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**


