## Dear Filer:

PLANNED PARENTHOOD PENNSYLVANIA ADVOCATES has failed to file the above-referenced reports in an electronic format. 11 CFR §104.18 states that any person/entity required to file reports with the Commission that receives contributions or makes expenditures in excess of \$50,000 in the current calendar year, or that has reason to expect to do so, must submit its reports electronically. Once filers exceed the \$50,000 threshold, they have "reason to expect" to exceed the threshold in the following two calendar years. Alternatively, persons/entities that have not met the electronic filing threshold but instead voluntarily files reports electronically must continue to file electronically for the remainder of the calendar year.

It is important that you file these reports in an electronic format immediately with the Federal Election Commission. Any filer who is required to file electronically, but instead files on paper, will be considered a nonfiler and may be subject to enforcement action. Your reporting obligation will not be satisfied until you file the above-reference reports in an electronic format.
