This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above. An itemization of the information needed follows:


- The Summary Page discloses \$469,325.26 on Line 7, Column B, but the Detailed Summary Page shows the Line 31, Column B total to be \$580,542.65. These figures should be the same. Please amend your report accordingly.
- Your calculations for Line 8, Column B appear to be incorrect. FEC calculations disclose this amount(s) to be \$122,548.96. Please provide the corrected total(s) on the Summary Page.
- The outstanding balance of a debt owed to a creditor at the close of one report should be exactly the same as the beginning outstanding balance of the next report. The December Monthly Report (11/1/03-11/30/03) shows an ending balance to "Strategies Creative" of \$3,330.76, while this report shows a beginning balance of \$8,330.76. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee.

Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
