This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Your May Monthly Report (4/01/06 – 4/30/06), June Monthly Report (5/01/06 – 5/31/06), and July Monthly Report (6/01/06 – 6/30/06) combined, disclose memo Schedule A's totaling \$5,035.00 for "Dollars for Democrats," which appears to be your committee's share of the gross contributions received from a joint fundraising committee. However, there are no corresponding transfers-in from the related joint fundraising committee disclosed on Schedule A supporting Line 12 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please amend your report(s) to clarify this apparent discrepancy.


-Your May Monthly Report (4/01/06 – 4/30/06), June Monthly Report (5/01/06 – 5/31/06), and July Monthly Report (6/01/06 – 6/30/06) combined, disclose memo Schedule A's totaling \$6,170.25 for "MS Party Victory Fund," which appears to be your committee's share of the gross contributions received from a joint fundraising committee. However, there are no corresponding transfers-in from the related joint fundraising committee disclosed on Schedule A supporting Line 12 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please amend your report(s) to clarify this apparent discrepancy.
