This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following item:

-A review of your reports discloses transfers between your committee and "PLUMBERS & STEAMFITTERS LOCAL 22 PAC INC", "PLUMBERS AND STEAMFITTERS LOCAL NO 73 FEDERAL PAC FUND", "PLUMBERS LOCAL 98 POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE", "UA LOCAL 38 COMMITTEE ON POLITICAL EDUCATION", and "SPRINKLER FITTERS LOCAL #704 POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE". However, you have not listed this organization(s) as an affiliated committee(s). All committees (including a separate segregated fund) established, financed, maintained or controlled by the same corporation, labor organization, person, or group of person including any parent, subsidiary, branch division, department, or local unit thereof, are affiliated. For further guidance on affiliated committees, please refer to 11 CFR §100.5(g) and §110.3.

If your committee is affiliated with the above referenced committee(s), please file an amended Statement of Organization listing said committee(s) on Line 6 along with all other affiliated committees. Additionally, if your committee has a new connected organization it should also be listed on Line 6. 11 CFR §102.2

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.
