

This Form 99 Miscellaneous Report is being filed in response to the letter from the Commission dated July 25, 2008, in which the Commission requests clarification with respect to certain disbursements included on ARDA PACs (the PAC) May Monthly Report. Among the issues raised in the letter is a contribution dated April 29, 2008 made to Andre Carson for Congress and which was designated for the 2008 Primary. The Commission notes that the PAC made a contribution dated March 4, 2008 to Andre Carson for Congress, which contribution was also designated for the 2008 Primary. The contribution dated March 4, 2008 was made in connection with the special election held on March 11, 2008 in which Rep. Carson was a candidate. Due to a clerical error, the contribution made by the PAC to Andre Carson for Congress was incorrectly designated on the PACs April Monthly report for the 2008 primary election. It should be noted that Rep. Carson reported the March 4, 2008 contribution as being received in connection with the Special General on both a 48-Hour Contribution Notice report and on his Post-Special Report. The PAC will amend its April Monthly Report to correctly designate the contribution to the Special General election. The Commissions letter also seeks clarification of certain disbursements included on the PACs May Monthly Report. Specifically, the letter cites disbursements for Administrative Service Fee/Overhead, Retainer for Fundraising Consulting, and Retainer/Fees for Fundraising Consulting Retainer and requests additional information for each. The Administrative Service Fee/Overhead disbursement was for legal services, legislative services, dues payments, staff salaries and overhead expenses. The PAC will amend its May Monthly Report to include this additional information. The disbursements for Retainer for Fundraising Consulting and for Retainer/Fees for Fundraising Consulting Retainer were made on behalf of the PAC and not for, or on behalf of, any specific
