As the treasurer of Freedom Committee and as Presidential Elect Ms. Diane M. Chisesi, I would like and explanation for the lack of cooperation not afforded to FREEDOM COMMITTEE and my campaign? I would also like to know why I have not had

a positive compensatory resolution in regard to this campaign.

As a Presidential Candidate I contend I have not been treated fairly and I would like this situation resolved. I am entitled to campaign funding. I have not been allowed to receive my IRS tax refund which allows me to provide for my family and to further my political financing and I find this to be entirely unacceptable and vulgar.

Please submit the appropriate paperwork to allow payments to my campaign thus establishing another campaign fund or make

a direct deposit to my business account. I need to participate to protect my integrity and my rights as a Presidential Candidate so as to help prevent our aggressors who with maligned discontent are trying to ruin this great country.

I will also briefly comment: "the far right"? This is an interesting thought progression specifically when it is coming from all our "left wingers". The Republican Party is a great party and the Democrats who are supporting the "right way" to commit to democracy are all of whom I would salute. We are all supposed to be in this race together-and in the long run-let the nation decide who they will entrust for this position. I am a lawful candidate and I want to be treated fairly. Please make headway and resolve this issue for the good of all.

Please note the following Internal Revenue Code:

? 9006. Payments to eligible candidates

(a) Establishment of campaign fund

There is hereby established on the books of the Treasury of the United States a special fund to be known as the ??Presidential Election Campaign Fund??. The Secretary of the Treasury shall, from time to time, transfer to the fund an amount not in excess of the sum of the amounts

designated (subsequent to the previous Presidential election) to the fund by individuals under section 6096. There is appropriated to the fund for each fiscal year, out of amounts in the general fund of the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, an amount equal to the amounts so designated during each fiscal year, which shall remain available to the fund without fiscal year limitation.

(b) Payments from the fund

Upon receipt of a certification from the Commission under section 9005 for payment to the eligible candidates of a political party, the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay to such candidates out of the fund the amount certified by the Commission. Amounts paid to any such candidates shall be under the control of such candidates.

(c) Insufficient amounts in fund

If at the time of a certification by the Commission under section 9005 for payment to the eligible candidates of a political party, the Secretary determines that the moneys in the fund are not, or may not be, sufficient to satisfy the full entitlements of the eligible candidates of all political parties, he shall withhold from such payment such amount as he determines to be necessary to assure that the eligible candidates of each political party will receive their pro rata share of their full entitlement. Amounts withheld by reason of the preceding sentence shall be paid when the Secretary determines that there are sufficient moneys in the fund to pay such

amounts, or portions thereof, to all eligible candidates from whom amounts have been withheld, but, if there are not sufficient moneys in the fund to satisfy the full entitlement of the eligible candidates of all political parties, the amounts so withheld shall be paid in such manner that the eligible candidates of each political party receive their pro rata share of their full entitlement. In any case in which the Secretary determines that there are insufficient moneys in the fund to make payments under subsection (b), section 9008(b)(3), and section 9037(b), moneys
