This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Your cover letter states that the cash discrepancy disclosed on this report "reflects un-cashed checks from previous reports" and that "nearly all of these checks are paychecks of prior employees who failed to pick them up." Since the checks written by your committee were not cashed, you should itemize these voided checks on Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) as negative entries. Please amend your report to properly report this activity.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
