Environmental/Conservation Alert

June 18, 1999

Unfortunately on June 17, 1999, the Michigan House of Representatives rejected changes to HB 4065 which would have ensured more money from the Clean Water Fund would go to actual water clean-ups. As an organization, Clean Water Action expended significant resources working to create the Clean Water Fund portion of the Clean Michigan Initiative and would like to see the money spent wisely.

Prior to the November 1998 elections, fancy television ads for the Clean Michigan Initiative suggested that the money would go to clean-up lakes and rivers. Clean Water Action, along with many Michigan voters, believed that a significant portion of the Clean Water Fund would go to the actual clean-up of polluted water. Unfortunately, the proposed rules for the Clean Water Fund overly skew the available funding to monitoring programs and set aside \$45 million for monitoring to make up for past budget cuts. This action is not only an imprudent use of bond money, but also betrays the voters who supported Proposal C believing that substantial money would go to water clean-up. Although SB 902 (the 1998 bill which created the \$90 million Clean Water Fund) stated that money could go to implement the department's strategic environmental quality monitoring program, it did not require that 50% of the Clean Water Fund be spent on monitoring programs.

WE CAN STILL MAKE A DIFFERENCE. Through the summer and fall, the Michigan House of Representatives will have opportunities to decide how to spend parts of the Clean Water Fund. Please write your letter now to help ensure that the Clean Water Fund dollars are spent to address Michigan's critical water quality needs.

Important Waterbodies Need Your Help

Through the summer and fall, the Michigan House of Representatives will decide how to spend parts of the Clean Michigan Initiative bond proposal (The "Environmental Bond" which voters approved last November. As part of the Clean Michigan Initiative, the Clean Water Fund was also approved and it contains \$90 million for water quality projects. Unfortunately, the state may squander this \$90 million which voters were led to believe would go to water clean-ups. The legislature is planning on holding hearings on the Clean Water Fund in the summer or fall

Please write your State Representative, Paul Gielegem and **THANK** him for voting to use money from the Clean Water Fund to address water quality problems. Also, ask him to support the following uses of the Clean Water Fund at future hearings and in future bills which deal with the Clean Water Fund:

FUND WATER CLEAN-UPS - By dedicating \$50 million for the clean-up and protection of priority waters such as Lake Superior, Lake St. Clair, and high quality rural waters.

SPEND THE BOND DOLLARS WISELY - by limiting the funding for water quality monitoring to \$10 million. Monitoring programs should be funded through the Department of Environmental Quality's budget not with bond dollars.

PROTECT DRINKING WATER SOURCES - by using \$2 million for the protection of drinking water sources.
