Dear Mr. Fox:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-The Summary Page discloses \$52,209.74 on Line 7, Column B but the Detailed Summary Page shows the Line 30, Column B total to be \$62,378.34. These figures should be the same. Please amend your report accordingly.

-The totals listed on Lines 30 and 31, Column B of the Detailed Summary Page(s) appear to be incorrect. Please be advised that you should add the "Calendar Year-to-Date" total from your previous report to the current "Total This Period" figure from Column A to derive the correct Column B totals. Please amend your report and any subsequent reports that may be affected by this correction.

-Your report discloses an outstanding balance(s) beginning this period for a debt(s) owed to A to Z Printing. However, an outstanding balance(s) at the close of the period was not disclosed on your 12 Day Pre-Primary Report. Please amend your report(s) to clarify this discrepancy.

-On Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i) of the Detailed Summary Page, your report disclosed contributions from individuals that omit the aggregate

year-to-date totals. Please amend your report by supplying the information.

-Schedule E of your report discloses \$1,492.26 in payments to your connected organization for independent expenditures on behalf of federal candidates (pertinent portions attached). An independent expenditure is an expenditure for a communication which expressly advocates the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate and which is not made with the cooperation or prior consent of, or in consultation with or at the request or suggestion of, any candidate or authorized committee or agent of a candidate. 11 CFR § 109.1(a) Please clarify whether these disbursements meet the definition of an independent expenditure. In addition, please amend your report to clarify whether the payments to your connected organization were made in advance of services rendered.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
