Upon discovery, the Florida Democratic Party took immediate action to both respond to the letters and implement preventative measures to avoid this oversight occurring in the future.

The Florida Democratic Party response is as follows:

In April of 2005 the Florida Democratic Party (FDP) received a "Request For Additional Information" letter, covering the period of August 2004, from the FEC. In response to this letter, FDP was instructed by the analyst to record an outstanding transfer as a debt.

Since debt totals roll forward, FDP amended its subsequent reports, including the ones referred to in the current "Request For Additional Information" letters dated 11.10.05 and 11.23.05.

During this time, FDP also noticed that a small number of invoices had been omitted from the debt schedules and promptly corrected the oversight in its amended reports.

In response to the RFAI letter dated 11/23/05, covering 09/01/05 - 09/30/05:

The Florida Democratic Party response is as follows:

1. The Florida Democratic Party had not received the proceeds from the joint fundraising activities by the end of the reporting period.
2. The debt for Lewis B. Freeman & Partners was incorrectly listed as Berger Singerman on the original September Monthly report. The debt for Sandler, Reiff and Young was omitted from the original September Monthly report. Both debts were correctly reported in the Amended September Monthly report filed on 11/21/2005.
3. The debt owed to Berger Singerman should have been listed as Lewis B. Freeman & Partners. The debt schedule was corrected in the Amended September Monthly report filed on 11/21/2005.
4. The payments for Audio Visual and Visual Audio Visual Services did not promote, support, attack or oppose a clearly identified candidate for Federal office.
