I am writing in response to your letter dated March 1, 1995, to Mr. Mitchell C. Kane, Treasurer of the Glaxo PAC, concerning a \$2,000.00 Glaxo PAC contribution on November 9, 1994, to the Bill Frist for Senate Committee, disclosed on the Glaxo PAC's 30 Day Post-General Report (10/20/94-11/28/94). Mr. Kane received this letter on March 6, 1995.

As you know from your conversation of March 7, 1995, with my partner, Cheryl Vienna, this contribution was intended to help retire the debt in connection with Mr. Frist's 1994 primary. The enclosed copy of the Glaxo PAC's contribution check shows that it was designated "For Primary Debt Retirement" on the face of the instrument. Unfortunately, the Schedule B for Line 23 accompanying the Glaxo PAC's 30 Day Post-General Report that disclosed this contribution showed the purpose of the contribution as "Debt Retirement '94" but inadvertently failed to note that it was in connection with the '94 primary and not the general election.

Accordingly, also enclosed you will find an amendment to the Glaxo PAC's 30 Day Post-General Report. This amendment consists of a 2-page Form 3X, as well as a replacement for page 6 of the 7-page Schedule B for Line 23 filed with the original report.
