Your July 5, 2001 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-Payments made to credit card companies must identify the original vendors from which you have purchased an item or service if your payments to these vendors have exceeded \$200 this year. Please amend your report by providing the mailing address, date, amount and purpose of all such payments as required by 11 CFR §104.9(b).

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by August 29, 2001. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions for time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered

by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
