As requested, and as discussed with EFAC's FEC report analyst, below is the response to the request for additional information referencing EFAC's April Quarterly Report (01/01/2016? 3/31/2016).

Item #1:

As previously reported in two FEC Form 99s filings (FEC-1054960 and FEC-1054961) related to the original FEC Form 5 filings (FEC-1054938 and FEC-1054949) submitted on 3/11/2016, no individual or organization has made a contribution or donation to further an independent expenditure.

Item #2:

As required, the April Quarterly report includes the dissemination date of two separate online ads. However, as these were online ads running concurrently and expenses were cumulative, the advertising managers were frequently adjusting the total amounts to be spent on multiple online platforms based on how users were viewing the ads. The FEC filings were submitted as soon as the best estimate of the aggregate threshold was available to the compliance team, since the report filers did not want to submit substantially incorrect data to the FEC. We have since adjusted our internal accounting and communications procedures to streamline the reporting for any future online advertising.

In addition, through a clerical error, we did not submit the April 15 quarterly report before the report deadline. Because our social welfare organization only infrequently engages in independent expenditures (our last reported activity took place in 2012), our internal administrators inadvertently missed the quarterly deadline. We ultimately (again at the recommendation of our report analyst) submitted two amended FEC Form 5 filings (FEC-1071594 and FEC-1071607) that reflected all transactions processed at the time of filing. We then immediately filed an April Quarterly report that reflected all reported transactions.
