On November 4, 1998, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.


Your November 18, 1998, response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-Your response states that several contributions to federal candidates were redesignated to the Primary Election. Please note that contributions may not be designated for an election that has already occurred unless the funds are to be used to reduce a candidate committee's debts incurred during that election campaign. Additionally, you need to provide the date(s) of redesignation for these contributions. If a recipient, candidate committee(s) does not have net debts outstanding from the Primary Election, you need to request a refund of the excessive contribution amount. Please clarify the corrective action taken by your committee and amend the appropriate report(s) as necessary.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
