Dear Ms Kelly:

This letter is in responseto your letter concerning our October 2005 Quarterly Report. Specifically this letter addresses our "best efforts" procedures to gather the full identification of all individuals who contribute in excess of \$ 200.00 in an election cycle.

The first step in the process is when we solicit funds we provide a card for the contributor to complete. The card contains Name, home address, city, state, zip code, home and office telephone numbers, e-mail address, occupation and employer. Additionally, it states that this information is required to be completed by federal law.

The second step in the process is when we attempt to contact the contributor by either mail, telephone or e-mail. These requests are documented either by copies of the correspondence or in the case of a telephone call a log of the call. This step is initiated within thirty days of receiving the contribution. If necessary we will make follow-up requests. The requests and thier follow-ups clearly ask for any missing information, without asking for a contribution; inform the contributor that this information is required by federal law; and if any of these requests are in writing we include a return envelope.

The third step in this process is to file an amended report for the period in question before the next report is due.

We believe that this procedure will result in us obtaining the information that we are required to submit to the Federal Election Commission.
