Dear Ms. Winship,

It was good to talk with you about the issues you noted in your letters referenced above.

In regards to:

A: Payments for salaries and wages were reported on Line 21b for the following individuals: David Throckmorton, Mychelle Brickner, Mark Skiles. These transactions have been moved to Line 30b; the amended reports have been refiled.

B: Around this time I experienced difficulty in successfully filing reports. After spending a lot of time working with the FEC Technical Support office which involved numerous opening and reclosing and refilings of several amended reports, the support technician stated the reports were apparently successfully filed. However, it now appears the previous reports were not successfully amended and refiled which seems to have caused the errors you noted. The reports in question have been amended and refiled so that the balances and totals will appear correctly.

C: The identification for individuals whose contributions total more than \$200 has been updated and I have attempted to re-file the amended report. This appears to have been caused by the individuals being entered multiple times into the database with slightly different names or addresses. I am working to merge individuals with multiple entries to prevent this from occurring in the future. (As note above, I am working with the FEC Technical Support Desk to resolve this issue.

D.

- 1. As also noted in Item A above, payments for wages and salaries were reported on Line 21b. These transactions have

been moved to Line 30b and I continue to work with the Technical Support desk to have the amended reports refiled.

2. As noted in Item C, the identification for individuals whose contributions total more than \$200 has been updated and I have attempted to file amended report. As noted above has been filed. This appears to have been caused by the individuals being entered multiple times into the database with slightly different names or addresses. We are working to merge individuals with multiple entries to prevent this from occurring in the future.

3. The Event Expenses and Fundraising Expenses were for the regular general membership committee meetings at local public schools and our annual 'pep rally breakfast' fundraiser. None of these expenditures, nor a portion thereof, were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates and therefore were not reported on any lines other than 21b.
