In regard to elements of reporting the verification and validation portions of the online site usage has not allowed the data to be successfully input online since October 13, 2015 and instead has been kept on file as Schedule E. hard copies instead. Over seventeen downloaded reports have been generated and remain online for future reference and also contains accumulative data, reports of the principle campaign committee.

As treasurer in keeping all required records of receipts and disbursements. 102.9 and 104.14(b). I hereby to attest a loss of 8 million, for bank loan, due to exigent circumstance and lack of cooperation. This loss contains liability and business expenses indicated on Federal Election Committee site by way of 24/48 Hour report of independent expenditures thus documenting timely participation with said bank and real estate agents. Responses has been limited from bank due to emergent situation from Oct 13, 2015 through 11/24/2015.

Quarterly Reports

Once an individual has become a candidate, his or her principal campaign committee (and other authorized committees) must file quarterly reports. 104.5(a). Quarterly reports cover activity through the end of the calendar quarter and are due on April 15, July 15 and October 15. The fourth quarterly report?called the year-end report?is due on January 31 of the following year (additional reports are required during the candidate?s election year; see below). All authorized committees must file quarterly reports, even if the candidate decides to retire, withdraws from the race prior to the primary election, loses the primary or drops out of the race prior to the general election. See 52 U.S.C. ?30104(a)(2). Committees must continue to file quarterly reports until the Commission notifies them in writing that their termination report has been accepted.

The Commission may waive a quarterly report if a pre-election report (see below) is due during the period beginning on the 5th day and ending on the 15th day after the close of the calendar quarter. 104.5(a)(1)(iii).
