The Federal Elections Commission has informed us that checks made to your campaign from our Political Action Committee (ENPAC) were designated for retirement of debts incurred by the 2002 Primary election campaign; but it appears that your committee had insufficient debts to warrant such contributions.


ENPAC issued check number 1893 to your campaign on September 4, 2002 and check number 2140 on September 25, 2002. In accordance with FEC laws the checks must be returned if it has not been re-designated towards a different election within 60 days after receipt by your Treasurer. FEC reports indicate that this check was received by your Treasurer and reported more than 60 days ago. Therefore, the check must be refunded to our PAC.

Upon receipt of your refund, ENPAC will immediately issue a new check for your next campaign cycle.


This letter is to inform you that as of April 2, 2003 the Commission has not received your response to our requests for additional information dated March 12, 2003. These notices request information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. To ensure compliance with the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act (the Act), please respond to these requests (copies enclosed).

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by April 23, 2003. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
