Dear Ms. Bonfiglio:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-The independent expenditure schedule (Schedule E) should disclose the following information: the name and mailing address of the payee, the purpose of the expenditure, the date of payment, the amount of payment, the name and office sought, state and district (if applicable) of the federal candidate, the calendar year-to-date, per election, for office sought total, the election designation, an indication of whether the candidate was supported or opposed and the signature of the treasurer. Please amend Schedule E by providing the name of each payee. 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3)(vii)

-Schedule B, supporting Line 21(b) of the Detailed Summary Page discloses negative disbursements totaling \$8,737.33 with a purpose of "See Schedule E". However, there is no apparent positive disbursement on Line 21(b) to account for these negative transactions. Please be advised that if the communication is paid in one reporting period and aired in a later reporting period, the independent expenditure should be disclosed on Schedule B, supporting Line 21(b), on the date paid. When the communication is publicly disseminated, a negative entry in the amount paid should appear on Line 21(b), with a reference to the original disbursement, and the total amount should appear on Schedule E, supporting Line 24. Please amend your report to include the original disbursement or provide clarifying information.

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-Your committee has filed a 24 hour notice on 10/28/04 for an independent expenditure totaling \$83.10 on behalf of George Bush which had not been itemized on Schedule E supporting Line 24 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please be advised that independent expenditures disclosed on 24 hour notices must also be itemized on a corresponding Schedule E or MEMO Schedule E and Schedule D (if applicable), in the appropriate reporting period. Further, if the actual payment(s) for the independent expenditure(s) occurs after the date of dissemination, the appropriate report(s) should continue to show a payment(s) on Schedule E and Schedule D, until the debt is fully extinguished. Please amend your report and any subsequent reports that may be affected by this correction.

-Your report discloses an apparent in-kind contribution(s) made on behalf of a federal candidate(s). It appears the original payment(s) for the goods and services have been itemized as an operating expenditure(s) and included in the total for Line 21(b) of both this and your 12 Day Pre-General Report.

Please be advised that if the goods/services were paid for in advance of when the candidate received them, the total amount of such activity should be reported on Schedule B for Line 21(b) on the date they were paid. When the candidate received the good/services, the total amount should be disclosed as a negative entry on Line 21(b) and reported as a positive entry on Schedule B for Line 23 of the Detailed Summary Page. This method of reporting would clarify for the public record the total amount of contributions to federal candidates, including in-kind contributions, by reflecting them on Line 23 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.

-Schedule B, supporting Line 23 of the Detailed Summary Page discloses memo in-kind contributions that relate to payments made on 10/21/04 and 10/25/04 to WSUA Broadcasting Corp. and Univision WAQI. However, there are no corresponding disbursements on Schedule B to account for these memo in-kinds contributions. Please be advised, a memo entry is used to disclose additional information about an itemized transaction and the amount of a memo entry is not included in the total receipts or disbursements for the report. Please amend your report to include the corresponding itemized disbursements or provide clarifying information regarding these transactions.

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated.


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Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
