This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 items:

1. Schedule A of your report discloses an in-kind contribution to your committee totaling \$9,970.50 from "Pamela J. Joyner". However, Schedule B of your report discloses a \$4,985.25 disbursement to this individual for "Offset For In-Kind Events". Please be advised that the full value of in-kind contributions must be added to the receipts and disbursements total in order to avoid either inflating or deflating the cash on hand amount, and itemized on the appropriate Schedules A and B. 11 CFR § 104.13(a)(2) Please amend your report by itemizing the in-kind contributions on Schedule B, or provide further clarification regarding this apparent discrepancy.


2. Schedule B of your report discloses an in-kind contribution to your committee from "Alfred J. Giuffrida". Please be advised that the value of in-kind contributions must be added to the receipts and disbursements total in order to avoid either inflating or deflating the cash on hand amount, and itemized on the appropriate Schedules A and B. 11 CFR § 104.13(a)(2) Please amend your report by itemizing the in-kind contributions on Schedule A.
