The Campaign for Working Families (FEC ID# C00325076) received your letters dated April 5, 2000 and the follow-up letter dated April 27, 2000 concerning our 1999-year end FEC report.


Concerning occupation and employer information, enclosed please find a sample committee solicitation. This solicitation, like all our solicitations, informs the donor that the committee is required to report this information, and asks that the donor provide it.

In addition, please find a sample of the letter we send to those donors whose contributions exceed \$200, but who do not provide us with their occupation and employer information when they send us their contribution. Further, all information received by the campaign is reported. In this manner, the committee believes it is meeting the best efforts provisions outlined in your letter.

We have amended the report so that the total for Line 11(a)(i) matches the total for the sum of the entries itemized on Schedule A. Also included in the amendment are the ultimate vendor listings supporting the credit card payments.

However, the beginning cash balance for this report, and the cash balance at January 1, 1999, are correct as reported. The committee has been conducting a thorough review of its recent financial activity, and has been able to complete and file the reports for the months of January and February 1998. All other amendments required will be filed as soon as the information can be verified.
