Enclosed are the following amended reports:

1. 1993 Mid-Year Report (1/1/93-6/30/94)
2. 1993 Year-End Report (7/01/93 - 12/31/93)

Also enclosed are the Amended Summary Sheets covering subsequent reports that were affected because of changes to the reports submitted for 1993.

The following corrections were made to the Mid-Year Report 1993 (1/1/93 - 6/30/94):

1. Schedule A of the Mid-Year Report 1993 discloses contributions which exceed the limits set forth in the Act 2 U.S.C. Section 441a(f) and 11 CFR Section 110.1(d) which preclude a committee from receiving contributions from another political committee or individual in excess of \$5,000 per calendar year. We have since sought to reattribute this contribution pursuant to 11 CFR Section 1101.1(4), transfer-out the amount in excess of \$5,000 to an account not used to influence federal elections. Each contributor has been contacted and has agreed to the reattribution to an account that does not influence federal candidates. Since all have agreed as of July 20, 1994 the transfer of \$6,400 has been made but cannot be reflected until the October 15, 1994 Quarterly Report is due. In that report it will reflect, in a memo entry, a transfer out of our Federal into our Non-Federal Account for the excess. The program used to print the report printed one contributor twice which then made the contributor's aggregate exceed \$5,000 which is an error. This has been corrected.

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2. The identification of the contributor who contributed in excess of \$200 in the aggregate (Mid-Year 1993 Report) has been corrected. The contributor who appeared to have been drawn on a corporate account was not. The report incorrectly listed his employer within the name, address, and city section instead of the name of the employer section.

The following corrections were made to the 1993 Year-End Report (7/01/93 - 12/31/94):

1. Line 6(a) of the Summary Page which represents the total cash-on-hand as of January 1, 1993 has been changed to reflect the accurate total.

2. The beginning cash balance discrepancy of this report reflects the ending balance of the 1993 Mid Year Report.

3. The total listed on Line 11(a) (i), Column B of the Detailed Summary Page has been corrected to reflect totals.

4. The total for Line 12(d), Columns A and B of the Detailed Summary Page have been added.

5. Schedule A of the report incorrectly disclosed the aggregate year to date amount for one contributor. I have searched the financial records and bank statement which show that T.W. Brady only contributed \$3,113 year to date. This also happened with Marianne Edmonds who only contributed \$2,780 year to date and James Eaton who only contributed \$5,000 year to date. I have discussed this problem with our computer programmer, he indicated it might not be reading the macro (calculation statement) correctly.

6. Based on copies of checks and financial records, Nat Hyman contributed funds from his personal account not his corporation. The Hyman Company should have been reflected in the space provided for Name of Employer.

7. Schedule A discloses contributions which exceed the limits set forth in the Act 2 U.S.C. Section 441a(f) and 11 CFR Section 110.1(d) which preclude a committee from receiving contributions from another political committee or individuals in excess of \$5,000 per calendar year. We have since sought to re attribute this contribution pursuant to 11 CFR Section 1101.1 (4), transfer-out the amount in excess of \$5,000 to an account not used to influence federal elections. Each contributor has been contacted and has agreed to the reattribution to an account that does not influence federal candidates. Since all have agreed as of July 20, 1994 the transfer of \$3,000 has been made but cannot be reflected until the October 15, 1994 Quarterly report is due. In that report it will reflect, in a memo entry, a transfer out of our Federal into our Non-Federal Account for the excess.




Please correct your records to reflect George E. Comerford as Treasurer for the Democratic Executive Committee of Florida. He has been Treasurer since December 1992.
