Please provide clarifying information as to why this activity was not disclosed on your original report. 11 CFR §104.3

-Your report discloses an outstanding balance(s) beginning this period for a debt(s) owed to "Willett, Jason." However, an outstanding balance(s) at the close of the period was not disclosed on your Amended Year End Report (12/1/05 – 12/31/05), received 3/13/06. Please amend your report(s) to clarify this discrepancy.


