Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following $\underline{4}$ item(s):

1. Itemized disbursements must include a brief statement or description of why each disbursement was made. Please amend Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) of your report to clarify the following description(s): "Voter Outreach" and "Environmental Services." For further guidance regarding acceptable purposes of disbursement, please refer to 11 CFR 104.3(b)(3)(i).

2. Your committee filed 48 hour reports informing the Commission of independent expenditures made in support or opposition of federal candidates with "Brass Tactics" as the payee(s). However, the amounts of public dissemination disclosed on these reports do not appear to correlate with the entries on Schedule E, supporting Line 24 for the reporting period. If your committee has filed 48 hour reports supporting independent expenditures not reflected on your reports, you must file Schedule E during the appropriate reporting period to disclose these payments. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy and provide further information concerning these reports. (11 CFR §104.4)

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3. Schedule E discloses Calendar Year-To-Date Per Election total(s) for the Senate race in Colorado which appear to be incorrect. Please amend your report to provide the correct total(s) on Schedule E. (52 U.S.C. \$30104(b)(4)) (formerly 2 U.S.C. \$434(b)(4)) and 11 CFR \$104.4(f))

4. Itemized independent expenditures must include a brief statement or description of why the expenditures were made. Please amend Schedule E of your report to clarify the following description(s): "Voter Outreach" and "Voter Outreach - (Previously Reported)." For further guidance regarding acceptable purposes, please refer to 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3).

- Schedule B of your report discloses an expenditure(s) for "Communications Consulting & Production Services," "Communications Consulting Services," "Direct Mail," "Mileage & **Printing**," "Printing," "Telephone Calls" and "Video Production Services." For your information and consideration when preparing future filings, if a portion or all of these expenditures were for public communications (as defined by 11 CFR §100.26) containing express advocacy as defined under 11 CFR §100.22, this would constitute an independent expenditure and would be disclosed on a Schedule E supporting Line 24. Public communications that refer to a clearly identified Federal candidate, but that do not expressly advocate the election or defeat of that candidate would be reported on Schedule B for Line 21(b) of the Detailed Summary Page.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
