Andrea Needles, Rpts Analysis Div: In response to your letter posted Nov. 27, '02, we have determined that we had some clerical errors (where disbursements were misclassified for the General Election where they were in fact issued prior to the Primary Election for that purpose) on the following reports that have been corrected, please note that no dollar amounts have been changed, and that they are being submitted to FEC electronically. The reports are: 1)Jan 31 Qrt Rpt (YE) 07/01/01 - 12/31/01 (the change was Enzi for US Senate, Disbursement for: General to Primary); 2)July 31 Mid-Year Rpt (Non-election Year Only) (MY) 01/01/2001 - 06/30/2001 (the change was Enzi for US Senate, Disbursement for: General to Primary and Stevens for Senate Committee, Disbursement for: General to Primary); 3)Oct 15 Qrt Rpt (Q3) 07/01/2000-09/30/2000 (the change was Stevens for Senate Committee, Disbursement for: General to Primary); 4)12-Day Pre-Election Report for the Election on 11/07/00 (10/01/00-10/28/00) (the change was Enzi for US Senate, Disbursement for: General to Primary). --The 2000 Year Reports have a number of validation errors that went through before the system was updated. The reports were previously signed by Roger Johnson who has since left the company and as instructed by you, Adrian Jackman's name will appear, Treasurer for PAC.
