This response is to answer questions raised by the Federal Election Commission's ("FEC") notification, dated 12/04/02, regarding information reported on the above referenced report.

Issue: Schedule D Outstanding Debts

Response: A review of the FEC's 06/21/02 letter relative to our debt settlement plan (DSP 02-01) does confirm that the status of the 12 vendors referenced in your 12/04/02 notification are still outstanding. An amended report filed electronically on 12/20/02 will disclose the outstanding debt to these 12 vendors on Schedule D.

As per your verbal recommendation to Julia K. Hassett on 12/17/02, we will file a new debt settlement plan with the FEC to include only these 12 vendors. This will be filed as soon as possible with Vicki Davis, FEC Compliance Analyst via first-class mail.

Issue: Apparent Excessive Contribution

Response: A refund to "Nadler for Congress" has been issued. An amended report filed electronically on 12/20/02 will include a notation on Schedule A for Line 11(c) to this effect. A photocopy of the refund check is being sent to your attention via first-class mail.

Issue: Itemized Disbursement Descriptions
