This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Line 23 of the Detailed Summary Page of your report discloses a total of \$0 in disbursements. The sum of the entries itemized on Schedule B, however, indicates the total to be \$23,110. Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy.

-Please provide a Schedule A to support the entry disclosed on Line 11(a)(i) of the Detailed Summary Page. All contributions from individuals/persons other than political committees aggregating in excess of \$200 per year must be itemized on Schedule A. 11 CFR §104.3(a)(2)


-Line 29 of the Detailed Summary Page discloses other disbursements during the reporting period. Please clarify whether this figure includes any disbursements to a payee, that aggregate greater than \$200 in the calendar year. If this is the case, please amend your report by itemizing the disbursements on Schedule B. 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(4)(H)(V)

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated.

Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
