This is in response to your letter of March 6, 1996 regarding the McDermott, Will and Emery PAC.

As you discussed earlier today with Evan Migdail, the contribution to Representative Kleczka dated December 14, 1995 in the amount of \$5,000 should have been designated as for the general election. The earlier contribution of \$1,000 dated April 17, 1995 was designated for the primary.

The contribution to Representative Gingrich dated September 1, 1995 in the amount of \$5,000 should have been designated for the general election. The earlier contribution of \$1,000 dated February 28, 1995 was designated for the primary.

On June 14, 1995 the PAC notified the FEC that it had obtained multicandidate status. As such, the contributions in question are within legal limits.

We shall redesignate the contributions in our next filing with the FEC in accordance with your request.
