This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Schedule(s) H2 disclose the fundraising event(s) "Donk-n-Liz (transfers) (6/20/2005)" and "Donkey Lizards (inkind) (6/09/2005)" as a 100% federal and 100% non-federal activity, respectively. Please note that by definition, 100% federal or non-federal activity does not qualify as a shared expense to be allocated between your federal and non-federal accounts. Please be advised that prohibited in-kind donations for allocable fundraising activities are allocated at the same ratio used to allocate fundraising activity expenses. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended. If you should have any
