This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following item:

-Your amended report discloses additional disbursements totaling \$31,017.49 on Lines 21(a)(i), 21(a)(ii) and 21(b) of the Detailed Summary Pages that were not disclosed on your original report. The Commission notes the inclusion of memo text that indicates the amendment was filed in order to include \$694.70 in additional disbursements not authorized by the committee. However, your report also discloses an additional \$30,322.79 in disbursements involving other activity. Please provide clarifying information as to why this \$30,322.79 in activity was not disclosed on your original report. 11 CFR §104.3


**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather
