This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following item:

-Schedule A of your report discloses one or more contributions totaling \$5,000.00 from "PBG, INC.," which appears to be a corporation(s). 2 U.S.C. §441b(a) prohibits the receipt of contributions from corporations unless made from a separate segregated fund established by the corporation.

If any apparently prohibited contribution in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you should amend your original report with clarifying information.

If you have received a prohibited contribution(s), you may have to make a refund. If within 30 days of receipt you (1) transferred the prohibited amount to an account not used to influence federal elections, and (2) provided written notice to the person making the contribution of the option of receiving a refund, you may retain the contribution in an account not used to influence federal elections. Any request from a donor for a refund must be honored.

If the foregoing conditions for transfers to a non-federal account were not met within 30 days of receipt, the prohibited amount must be refunded. See 11 CFR §103.3(b)(1).

Please inform the Commission of your corrective action immediately in writing and provide a photocopy of your check for any transfer-out or refund. In addition, any transfers-out or refunds should be disclosed on Schedule B supporting Line 22 or 28 of the report covering the period during which the transaction was made.

The Commission notes the memo text attached to the reports stating, "the PAC is now refunding the contributions pursuant to 11 C.F.R. 103.3(b)(2). The amended reports reflect the corporate source of the contributions; the refunds will appear on the PAC's next report." Although the Commission may take further legal action concerning the acceptance of a prohibited contribution, prompt action by your committee to transfer-out or refund the amount will be taken into consideration.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended. In response to the FEC's June 4, 2008, letter from Corbin T. Jones requesting additional information, the Trucking Political Action Committee Of The American Trucking Associations, Inc. (C00002881) filed copies of the requested refund checks. As stated in the PAC's May 21, 2008, filing, the PAC refunded the contributions pursuant 11 C.F.R. 103.3(b)(2). The PAC determined on May 6, 2008 that the contributions were impermissible and refunded the contributions on May 21, 2008 in compliance with the 30-day refund requirement contained in that regulatory provision. Mr. Corbin also stated over the telephone on June 9, 2008, that the PAC's May 21 explanation adequately addresses the other issues raised in his letter and that no additional explanatory information would be necessary at this time.

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

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
