Dear Mr. Herrera:

By letter dated October 23, 1997, you were notified that the Political Reform Division, Office of the Secretary of State in California did not have your committee's 1997 Mid-Year Report on file. The Federal Election Campaign Act requires campaign committees to file a copy of each report with the state office at the same time the report is filed with the Federal Election Commission.

The letter asked that a copy of the report be filed with the state office. To date, I have not received a response from your committee indicating that the report was filed. As stated in the letter, a failure to file with the state office will result in a "Notice Of Failure To File" being placed on the public record.
