Dear Ms. Williamson:

In reference to our earlier conversation, I would like to address the items listed in your reviews of two of WALPAC's reports:

The \$750.00 contribution to Cal Dooley for Congress, dated 5/22/00, will go towards primary debt retirement.

The \$2000.00 contribution for Mike DeWine For Senate should be re-designated from primary to general. The campaign committee will be notified.

The \$500.00 contribution for Re-Elect Brian Bilbray For Congress should be re-designated from primary to general. The campaign committee will be notified.

I also understand that once you electronically file reports, you are expected to continue. However, there was a footnote placed on WALPAC's Termination Report, showing where the funds left in our account will be sent. I called the FEC prior to completing the Termination Report to find out where you could place notes on an electronic filing. FEC STAFF advised me that notes could not be added to an electronic filing, and if I wanted to add a note to the report, then the note would have to be added manually and filed in person.

Hope this helps to clear up any issues. At this point, I do not have access to my computer with the FEC software; so I am unable to re-do any reports.


