Dear Ms. Arkley:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Form 5 indicates that your committee may have failed to file one or more of the required 48 hour notices regarding independent expenditures that your committee has made (see attached). The Bipartisan Campaign Reform Act (BCRA) requires political committees and other persons who make independent expenditures at any time during a calendar year – up to and including the 20th day before an election – to disclose this activity within 48 hours each time that the expenditures aggregate \$10,000 or more. To ensure that the Commission is notified of all independent expenditures that aggregate \$10,000 or more, it is recommended that you review your procedures during the aforementioned time period. The failure to file 48 hour notices regarding independent expenditures may result in civil money penalties or legal enforcement action. If any independent expenditure was incorrectly reported, you must amend your original report with the clarifying information. (11 CFR 104.4(b) and (f) and 109.10(c))

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee.



Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
