In response to a request for information from the Federal Election Commission (FEC) dated, September 28, 2001, and for the reason set forth below, I hereby request that the contribution made by the Water Well PAC on April 6, 2000 be refunded.

The Water Well PAC does not qualify as multi-candidate PAC, therefore are limited to contributions of \$1,000 per election. A contribution was made on March 22, 1999 for \$500, which would leave the Water Well PAC eligible to contribute another \$500 for the election cycle.
