Dear Mr. Norfleet:

This letter is in response to your letter of inquiry dated August 8, 2008.

The American Council of Engineering Companies (ACEC/PAC) has recently undergone an external audit of PAC activity covering January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2007. As a result of this audit, we discovered that our committee's reported available cash balance was incorrect. After consulting with our campaign finance analyst at the time, Marlene Daughtrey, we were advised to begin the 2008 June Monthly report with the correct cash balance for the period. This correction resulted in the discrepancies that you noted in your Request for Additional Information dated August 8, 2008.

In order to correct these discrepancies we will amend the 2008 May Monthly FEC report and all other reports that were impacted by this change. However, the 2008 June Monthly report does not require an amendment.

In addition, misreporting due to recordkeeping and data entry errors found during the course of the audit requires that we amend all reports beginning with the 2005 February Monthly report, and ending with the 2008 May Monthly report. We are correcting and will file these amendments as soon as possible.
