This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 4 items:

1. The beginning cash balance of this report should equal the ending balance of your 30 Day Post-General Report (10/16/08–11/24/08). Please clarify this discrepancy and amend any subsequent report(s) that may be affected by this correction.
2. Your report discloses an outstanding balance beginning this period for a debt owed to "WEIRZBICKI, JOSEPH III." However, an outstanding balance at the close of the period was not disclosed on your 30 Day Post-General Report (10/16/08–11/24/08). Please amend your report(s) to clarify this discrepancy.
3. Please clarify all expenditures made for "Internet Fundraising & Newsletter" on Schedule B. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedules B or E supporting Lines 23 or 24 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate. 11 CFR §§104.3(b) and 106.1
4. Schedule B discloses an expenditure for "DVD Copy Costs." If a portion or all of these expenditures were for public communications (as defined by 11 CFR §100.26) or voter drive activity (under 11 CFR
