Dear Ms. Adame-Wilson:

The Squire Patton Boggs PAC (Identification Number C00401083) received a Request for Additional Information on August 22, 2016 regarding the July Monthly Report covering 06/01/2016 to 06/30/2016. The Federal Election Commission ("FEC") inquired about excessive contributions from Robert Gregg for \$171.42 and Stephen Nash for \$3,000.00 to the PAC. These amounts exceeded the \$5,000.00 limit. The Squire Patton Boggs PAC has taken corrective action and refunded those amounts.

Additionally, the Squire-Patton Boggs PAC inadvertently reported a contribution to the "Wyden for Senate" campaign committee for the Primary Election. This clerical error has been corrected and the July Monthly Report has been amended to reflect the proper designation of General Election for the contribution. Enclosed is the corresponding information to reflect that change.

The Squire Patton Boggs PAC (Identification Number C00401083) received another Request for Additional Information on September 14, 2016 regarding the August Monthly Report covering 07/01/2016 to 07/31/2016. The Federal Election Commission ("FEC") inquired about excessive contributions from Robert Gregg for \$257.13 and Justs Karlsons for \$2,500.00 to the PAC. The Squire Patton Boggs PAC has taken corrective action and refunded the amount to Robert Gregg.

The 7/31/2016 contribution by Justs Karlsons for \$2,500.00 was never actually sent to the Squire Patton Boggs PAC and thus was never deposited into the Squire Patton Boggs PAC bank account. The August Monthly Report has been amended to show a negative entry on Line 11. Enclosed is the corresponding information to reflect that change.

Enclosed are photocopies of the following checks:

- **Robert Gregg for \$428.55.**
 - This accounts for the contribution of \$171.42 on 6/30/16 included on the 2016 July Monthly Report.

- This accounts for the contribution of \$257.13 on 7/31/16 included on the 2016 August Monthly Report.
- **Stephen Nash for \$3,000.00.**
 - This accounts for the overage for the contribution of \$5,000.00 on 6/30/2016. Mr. Nash previously contributed \$3,000.00 on 1/31/16. Thus, Mr. Nash is now at the appropriate maximum limit for 2016.

The Squire Patton Boggs PAC will report these refunds on Line 28 of the October Monthly Report.

It is our understanding that this letter serves as the written response necessary for both the August 22, 2016 Request for Additional Information and the September 14, 2016 Request for Additional Information. This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 1 item(s):

- Schedule A of your report (see attached) discloses one or more contributions which appear to exceed the limits set forth in the Act. Please be advised that 52 U.S.C. §30116(f) (formerly 2 U.S.C. §441a(f)) and 11 CFR §§110.1(d) and 110.2(d) prohibit a committee and its affiliates from receiving any contribution from another political committee or person in excess of \$5,000 per calendar year.

If any apparently excessive contribution in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you must amend your original report with the clarifying information.

If any contribution you received exceeds the limits, you may have to refund the excessive amount. 
