The Air Line Pilots Association Political Action Committee (ALPA-PAC) has been informed by the Federal Election Commission (FEC) that ALPA-PAC has exceeded campaign finance limits in contributing \$10,000 to the primary campaign of U.S. Senator Robert Menendez.

In June 2005, ALPA-PAC made a \$5,000 primary contribution to Menendez for Congress and in April 2006 another \$5,000 primary contribution was made out to Menendez for Senate.

Normally, ALPA-PAC would provide authorization for the redesignation of \$5,000 toward the Menendez for Senate general election. However, since ALPA-PAC failed to discover this mistake and redesignate the excessive amount within the FEC's 60-day limit, ALPA-PAC is now required to obtain a \$5,000 refund from Menendez for Senate.

ALPA-PAC will inform the FEC of this corrective action and also requests that Menendez for Senate amend its FEC report to reflect a \$5,000 refund to ALPA-PAC. Upon receipt of the refund, ALPA-PAC will re-issue a \$5,000 contribution correctly designated to the Menendez for Senate general election.

The Air Line Pilots Association Political Action Committee (ALPA-PAC) has been informed by the Federal Election Commission (FEC) that it has exceeded finance limits in contributing \$6,000 to the primary campaign of U.S. Representative Ellen Tauscher.

In June 2005, the United Pilots Political Action Committee (UP-PAC), which falls under the organizational umbrella of ALPA for FEC reporting purposes, made a primary contribution of \$1,000 to Ellen Tauscher for Congress. However, since ALPA-PAC failed to discover and redesignate the excessive amount within the FEC's 60-day limit, ALPA-PAC is now required to obtain a \$1,000 refund from Ellen Tauscher for Congress.

ALPA-PAC will inform the FEC of this corrective action and requests that Ellen Tauscher for Congress amend its FEC report to reflect a \$1,000 refund to ALPA-PAC.
