This is in reply to your letter dated January 12, 2000, regarding the above referenced monthly report, specifically the refund listed on Schedule B to CMM Inc., in the amount of \$6,100.60.


Our records indicate that on July 22, 1999, a representative from CMM Inc. contacted our office and advised that several remittances had been sent to us in error and were intended for members' benefits, rather than our campaign assistance fund. We researched our records and found that on April 13, 1999, we received a check made payable to Boilermaker-Blacksmith LEAP - CAF for \$1,839.46 (deposited 4/15/99), on May 17, 1999, we received a check for \$1,954.85 (deposited 5/20/99), and on June 17, 1999, we received a check for \$2,306.29 (deposited 6/24/99), which were deposited into our Campaign Assistance Fund and subsequently included as unitemized contributions. These contributions were reflected on our May Monthly Report (4/1/99 - 4/30/99), June Monthly Report (5/1/99 - 5/31/99) and July Monthly Report (6/1/99 - 6/30/99). It was not necessary to itemize these contributions as they did not exceed the \$200.00 allowed per calendar year per individual.


# MEMORANDUM

August 6, 1999

It has come to my attention that three checks in the amounts of \$1839.46, \$1954.85, and \$2306.29, received from CMM Inc. (and made payable to Boilermaker Blacksmith LEAP-CAF) were sent in error and the entire amount was not intended for the Boilermaker CAF fund (we were able to "catch" a fourth check for \$1887.10 before it was deposited).
