Dear Mr. Buckley,

I am writing in response to your letter of June 18, 2008. I have amended the April Quarterly Report of 1/1/08-3/31/08 to correct my mistakes on it.

As to the first item, regarding the 80-20 Educational Foundation, I incorrectly designated the revenue as income when it was an offset to operating expenses. I have re-filed these items under the correct category.

As to your second item, regarding PNC Bank, I seek further clarification on what the problem is. 80-20 PAC has always used this bank and we have never had trouble when reporting our bank interest income under this bank name before.

I believe I have also addressed the third and fourth items by writing in a more specific description for the reimbursement item, and by providing descriptions for each disbursement of over \$100 as required by the law.

I discovered that I incorrectly reported the voter education ads, which should be independent expenditures. I apologize for the extremely late notice; I have re-filed the ads under the correct schedule (Schedule E).

As to your final item, because 80-20 is a cyberspace-based organization, we do not have administrative expenses such as rent or utilities. We do, however, have salary and internet expenses, which have already been filed correctly.
