Dear Sirs:

Your letter referenced above indicated the existence of an excessive contribution for the 1998 primary election from the PMA PAC to the Patrick Kennedy for Congress campaign. I have reviewed our records and concur with your assessment.

The Patrick Kennedy campaign staff has been requested to re-designate the PMA PAC February 17, 1998 \$1000 1998 primary contribution to reflect \$500 for the 1998 primary and \$500 for the 1998 general election campaigns. Enclosed is a copy of our letter requesting the re-designation. I believe this action should cure the excessive contribution problem. The PMA PAC Second Quarter 1998 Report will reflect a memo entry to document the re-designation.

I regret the error and I believe we have identified the internal administrative procedures which have permitted the PMA PAC's three recent excessive contribution problems. I remain hopeful that a similar error will not occur in the future. I appreciate the assistance and courtesy of the FEC staff.

The Federal Election Commission has recently notified PMA PAC of an excessive contribution to the Patrick Kennedy for Congress campaign. This was created by a \$500 July 22, 1997 contribution for the 1998 primary election followed by a second \$1000 primary contribution on February 17, 1998. As a non-multicandidate political committee, PMA PAC is limited to contributing \$1,000 per election.

As we discussed on the phone, PMA PAC would like to re-designate the February 17, 1998 \$1000 primary contribution as \$500 for the 1998 primary and \$500 for the 1998 general election campaign. This will correct our 1998 primary election excessive contribution.
