Dear Mr. Alpert:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** Additional information is needed for the following item:

-Schedule B supporting Line 29 discloses \$100,000 in transfers to what appears to be a non-federal account of your committee. The following memo text is attached to the transaction:

"This \$100,000 transfer is being made to correct an accounting error that took place in 2002. In October 2002, the committee received a \$100,000 non-federal loan that passed through its federal account. Although the committee immediately transferred the \$100,000 loan to a non-federal account, due to an accounting error, a second \$100,000 transfer was made. Although the committee intended to correct this error, due to an oversight, the error was not corrected. The committee has been carrying a \$100,000 adjustment ever since. Since the committee no longer intends to recoup the \$100,000 transfer, the committee is making this adjustment to adjust its reconciliations and cash on hand to properly reflect actual federal cash-on-hand."

Please be advised that any financial activity occurring outside this reporting period should be included in the appropriate report(s). 2 U.S.C. §434(b). Please provide further clarification regarding this transfer(s) to your non-federal account and amend any previous report(s) that may be affected by this correction.

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**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
