Dear Mr. Norfleet:

I am writing in response to your letter dated February 4, 2009 regarding the above-referenced report filed by the Pharmerica Corporation Political Action Committee (PPAC). Specifically, your letter concerns contributions made by PPAC to Pallone for Congress on October 20, 2008 for \$4,000, People for English on October 23, 2008 for \$3,000, and Texans for Senator John Cornyn Inc on October 20, 2008 for \$3,000, which contributions were listed on the above-referenced report as being made in connection with the 2008 general election.

Your letter notes that PPAC has appeared to have exceeded the contribution limit to the above-referenced committees in connection with the 2008 general election. This conclusion was reached by combining with the contributions made by PPAC, contributions made by the AmerisourceBergen Corporation Political Action Committee (ABC PAC) (FEC ID C00400929). At one time, PPAC and ABC PAC were affiliated committees. On August 10, 2007, both PPAC and ABC PAC filed with the Federal Election Commission, amendments to their respective statements of organization ending the affiliation between the two committees. All contributions above were made after the disaffiliation of PPAC and ABC PAC.

Moreover, neither PPAC nor ABC PAC made any contributions to the above-referenced committees in connection with the 2008 general election prior to disaffiliation. The above contributions, therefore, should not be aggregated and do not exceed the limits set forth in 2 U.S.C. 441a(a).
