This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following  $\underline{2}$  item(s):

**1.** On Schedule B supporting Line 17 of your report, you have itemized disbursements for which you have failed to include the purpose. Please amend your report to include the missing information. (11 CFR \$ 104.3(b)(4))

**2.** Your calculations for a loan on Schedule C is incorrect (Original Amount of Loan - Cumulative Payment to Date = Balance Outstanding at Close of This Period). (11 CFR § 104.3(d)) For the loan owed to Chad Wilbanks in amount of 7,000.00, the payment to date amount exceeds the original loan amount resulting in a negative outstanding balance. Please amend your report to correct the discrepancies for the attached loans.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
