On January 20, 2005, PWA Board Member Joan Bowman loaned PWA \$3,500 via a deposit into PWA's federal account from Ms.

Bowman's personal funds (the 'Loan'). The Loan was made to cover checks PWA had written on its federal account around that time period. On February 3, 2005, PWA repaid Ms. Bowman \$3,500 by check No. 1506 drawn on PWA's federal bank account (a copy of this check was mailed to the Federal Elections Commission at 999 E Street NW, Washington D.C. 20463 on April 9, 2014). Despite having been repaid in full on February 3, 2005, the Loan has been erroneously reported as 'unpaid' on each of PWA's committee reports filed with the FEC since April 2005. On March 20, 2006 Ms. Bowman wrote a letter to the F.E.C. explaining the above. PWA mistakenly believed that Ms. Bowman's March 20, 2006 letter was sufficient to remove Loan from PWA's future F.E.C. committee reports. In April 2014 conversations between PWA Treasurer Kathleen Ley and Armand at the FEC (Reports Analysis Dep't.), PWA discovered that Ms. Bowman's March 20, 2006 letter in

fact did not remove the \$3,500 loan from PWA's reports, nor was the March 20 letter sufficient to show that the Loan had been fully repaid on February 3, 2005. The intent of this submission is to explain the removal of the \$3,500 loan (deemed 'forgiven') from PWA's April 2014 Quarterly Report given that the loan was properly repaid by PWA on February 3, 2005.
