Dear Mr. Morse:

We have your letter of December 15, 2004 concerning the above captioned monthly report. We have reviewed your inquiry and in response, are providing you with the following information, as well as, an amended report for October 2004.

(1) You indicate that the totals listed on Lines 7, 23, 31, and 32 of Column B on the Summary and Detailed Summary Pages of this report are incorrect. For your information, TARPAC utilizes compliance software provided by VOCUS. It appears that the VOCUS software made an error on those lines (7, 23, 31, and 32) when the August 2004 disbursement totals were added to the September 2004 disbursement totals. The attached amendment corrects that software error.

(2) You indicate that the beginning cash balance of this report does not equal the ending balance of the amended monthly report for September 2004. It appears that the VOCUS software made an error of \$2000.00 when the August 2004 disbursement totals were added to the September 2004 disbursement totals. The attached amendment corrects that software error as well.


(3) You indicate that a contribution listed on Schedule B and made to the "A Lot of People Supporting Daschle, Inc." Committee on September 1, 2004 appears to be excessive. Please be advised that this contribution was "e-marked" by a TARPAC contributor, forwarded by TARPAC as instructed by the original contributor, and was properly reported as such.

(4) You indicate that one of the two contributions made to the "Lpton for All of Us" Committee, the first on August 2, 2004 and the second on September 28, 2004, may have been excessive. Please be advised that the first contribution, on August 2, 2004, was made as a

"primary" contribution but was inadvertently marked as a "general" election contribution on the monthly report. The attached amendment corrects that inadvertent error.

In addressing the Upton correction on the August filing, we have discovered an additional VOCUS software error. It appears the VOCUS software previously failed to pick-up a debt retirement contribution made by TARPAC in August 2004. The disbursement was made by TARPAC, received by the federal campaign, and cashed by the federal campaign. The disbursement was entered in to the VOCUS software program, but evidently not picked up in the filing. By way of this letter, we notify you of the error, and ask for guidance in how to make correction of the situation.
