
Please be advised that if a committee files an amendment to a report that was filed electronically, it shall also submit the amendment in an electronic format. 11 CFR §104.18(f) The Commission is in receipt of your electronic amendment received March 8, 2002. However, your paper filing dated March 12, 2002 will not be considered an amended report. To amend your report, you must respond to all the issues addressed in our letter in an electronic format.

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by April 10, 2002. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
