This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. Please be advised, a separate segregated fund is a political committee established, financed, maintained or controlled by a corporation, labor organization, membership organization, cooperative or trade association. If your committee is a separate segregated fund, an amended Statement of Organization should be submitted which indicates the appropriate Type of Committee on Line 5(e). Please amend your filing to clarify this apparent discrepancy.

-Your report was filed on an obsolete FEC FORM 1. Please be advised that all political committees are now required to use the FEC FORM 1 (revised 2/03). The new form can be downloaded from the FEC web site at <http://www.fec.gov>, or requested through the FEC Faxline at (202) 501-3413. Please re-submit your report using the new FEC Form 1. (11 CFR §104.2)


Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date

will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
